DAY 1

Travel into Virginia's Shenandoah Valley with the first stop at the American Celebration on Parade Museum. Experience the pageantry of spectacular parade floats from famous national celebrations like the Rose Parade and Presidential Inaugurals. Next, you will visit the internationally famous Luray Caverns. You will discover Eastern America's largest and most popular caverns. You'll hear the haunting sounds of the world's only Stalacpipe Organ. In addition, experience the history of America in the adjacent Car & Carriage Museum which houses an exhibition of over 140 original items related to transportation including cars, carriages, coaches and costumes dating from 1725. While at Luray Caverns, you will enjoy a buffet lunch. Board the coach for a scenic drive to your lodging host for the next two nights - the Natural Bridge Hotel. The Natural Bridge Hotel features colonial style décor and spectacular mountain views. After checking into the hotel, we will enjoy a full buffet dinner. The evening will be capped off with a fantastic sound and light display at Natural Bridge - The Drama of Creation. An impressive system of lighting transforms the Bridge and glen into a marvel of living stone. Scenes move and change with the mood of the gripping music in a spectacle which takes onlookers back into the eternal ages.

DAY 2

After a hearty buffet breakfast at our host hotel, it is on to Natural Bridge, Monacan Indian Living History Village, and Cedar Creek Trail and Nature Park. Natural Bridge is 215 feet high and 40 feet thick. The arch itself has a span of 90 feet, and it is higher than Niagara and as old as dawn. For a breathtaking experience, descend into the ravine to Cedar Creek and pause 215 feet below the span of the Bridge. Before departing take time to shop in the Natural Bridge gift shop. Next we take a short drive to historic Lexington, VA for a brief stop at the Lee Chapel and Museum. The museum features a statue of Robert E. Lee, his office, crypt and Traveler's grave. Relax and enjoy some free time in downtown Lexington for shopping and lunch on your own. Next, take a narrated, horse-drawn carriage ride through the streets of Lexington and learn about the final resting place of both Lee and Stonewall Jackson. We depart Lexington for an interesting adventure complete with lions and tigers and zebras oh my! The Virginia Safari park is a 180-acre preserve with hundreds of free-roaming animals that you may see during your guided wagon tour. After a busy day of touring, it is back the Natural Bridge Hotel for a full buffet dinner and time to enjoy the rocking chairs on the front porch or marvel at the lush mountain scenery.

DAY 3

Following a full breakfast buffet, we will board the coach and begin our journey north toward Charlottesville, VA home of Thomas Jefferson's Monticello. View many of our third President's inventions and original furnishings in this architectural masterpiece. We will take a guided tour through the house, gardens, and plantation that is Thomas Jefferson's Monticello. Explore the new Visitor's Center on the estate grounds and learn more about the man who authored the Declaration of Independence. Following the tour, we will travel a few miles down the road to the Michie Tavern. The tavern has welcomed travelers for more than 200 years.
